**PRIVACY NOTICE—MEDICAL INFORMATION
ATTACHMENT FOR RESIDENTS OF MARYLAND**

Genetic Information: We will not require or use genetic tests or genetic information to make certain underwriting decisions as required by Maryland law. We will not release identifiable genetic information or the results of a genetic test to any person who is not our employee or your health care provider without your prior written authorization for each disclosure, and only for the purpose of providing medical care or conducting research.

Inspection of Medical Files: Any agent of an applicant or claimant that requests to review the medical file of the applicant or claimant must have an authorization to review the medical records signed by the applicant or claimant.

Disclosure of Medical Records: If we disclose the contents of an insured's medical records without the insured's authorization to a policyholder, we will do so only if the policyholder does not further disclose the specific medical

information and the information is required for an audit of the billing made by the insurer to the policyholder.

Account Numbers: We will not make certain disclosures of policy numbers to a nonaffiliated third party for use in telemarketing, direct mail marketing, or other marketing through electronic mail, unless permitted by Maryland law.

Authorizations: If an individual provides us with an authorization to disclose medical information, the authorization will include the identity of the individual, and it shall not remain valid for longer than 24 months. An authorization may be revoked at any time subject to the rights of an individual who acted in reliance on the authorization before notice of the revocation.
